

Re: Docket No. 07-10-11RE01 – DPUC Proceeding to Establish Administrative Guidelines for the Public, Educational and Governmental Programming and Education Technology Investment – Grant Eligibility Criteria and Guidelines

Dear Mr. Gaudiosi,

I am writing on behalf of Comcast of Connecticut (“Comcast”) in response to the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority’s (the “Authority”) August 16, 2019 Notice of Request for Written Comments in connection with the above-referenced proceeding (the “Notice”).

The Notice states that the Authority opened the instant proceeding for the limited purpose of reviewing the eligibility requirements for receiving grants from the public, educational and governmental programming and education technology investment account (“PEGPETIA”) and the guidelines to be used to evaluate PEGPETIA applications.¹

Comcast respectfully submits that in issuing the grants, the Authority should be guided by “future cable-related community needs and interests,” consistent with the principles of federal law governing cable franchises.² As the Authority is aware, PEGPETIA grant funds are generated from the rates paid by cable subscribers. Accordingly, the Authority should prioritize disbursement of those funds for the benefit of those same cable subscribers.
